

**Public Notice**  
**Availability of Draft Business Impact Analysis for Comment**  
**OAC Chapter 3745-104, "Accidental Releases Prevention Program"**

Please note that in accordance with Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 119.032 (5-year rule review), the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) has reviewed the rules contained in Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Chapter 3745-104, "Accidental Releases Prevention Program." The rules in this chapter implement an accidental release prevention program, or Risk management Plan (RMP) program in accordance with Section 112(r) of the Federal Clean Air Act. The objective of section 112(r) is to prevent serious chemical accidents that have the potential to affect public health and the environment.

Based on our review, Ohio EPA believes these rules remain necessary, but are without need of change.

As part of the rulemaking process, Ohio EPA is required to prepare and submit a Business Impact Analysis (BIA) form to Ohio's Common Sense Initiative (CSI) Office. Ohio EPA is also making this form available at this time for public review and comment.
