Availability of Draft Business Impact Analysis for Comment
OAC Chapters 3750-10, 3750-20, and 3750-75, SERC/EMA Administrative Rules

Please note that on behalf of the director of the State Emergency Response Commission (SERC) and in accordance with Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 119.032 (5-year rule review), the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) has reviewed rules contained in Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Chapters 3750-10, 3750-20, and 3750-75. The rules in these chapters contain the administrative requirements for the SERC and the state Local Emergency Planning Committees (LEPCs). Our review indicates that these rules remain necessary, but are without need of change at this time.

As part of the rulemaking process, Ohio EPA is required to prepare and submit a Business Impact Analysis (BIA) form to Ohio's Common Sense Initiative (CSI) Office. Ohio EPA is making this form available at this time for public review and comment.
