

NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF RULES
OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY
Facility Emergency and Hazardous Chemical Inventory Form Rule

Notice is hereby given that, on behalf of the state emergency response commission (SERC), the Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), under the authority of Ohio Revised Code Section 3750.02 has adopted amended rule 3750-30-20 of the Ohio Administrative Code.

The amended rule language incorporates new data elements and revises some existing data elements on the Emergency and Hazardous Chemical Inventory Form under the Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act. The amendments make Ohio's rule equivalent to the federal requirements.

The Director's order of adoption was issued on Tuesday, September 2, 2014. **These adopted rules will become effective on Friday, September 12, 2014.**

The Director's action in this matter is pursuant to the procedural requirements of Ohio Revised Code Chapter 119 and is based upon the record of the public hearing conducted by Ohio EPA on July 17, 2014. No comments were received during the proposed rule comment period or the public hearing.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00, made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio," which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section.
