Revision to Lead Attainment Demonstration
State Implementation Plan (SIP)

Notice is hereby given that the Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) is submitting to the United States Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) a revision to the Lead SIP, for the partial Cuyahoga County, Ohio nonattainment area (The area enclosed on the west by Washington Park Boulevard/Crete Avenue/East 49th Street, on the east by East 71st Street, on the north by Fleet Avenue, and on the south by Grant Avenue).

This area was designated as a nonattainment area under provisions contained in the Clean Air Act (CAA). On June 25, 2012, Ohio EPA submitted Ohio's plan for attaining and maintaining the lead NAAQS in this area. Lead emitting operations at Ferro Corporation – Cleveland Frit Plant were analyzed and allowable emission limitations were incorporated into this areas attainment demonstration. Since the 2012 submittal, Ferro has requested to add an additional mill to their lead operations. Ohio EPA analyzed the requested change and determined due to reductions in lead emissions from additional controls added as part of the attainment demonstration in 2012, the addition of this mill will not require an increase in allowable emissions. Ohio EPA is revising Ferro's permit (see the Public Notice for Issuance of Draft Air Pollution Permit-To-Install) and the attainment demonstration to identify the additional mill and to maintain the current federally-enforceable emission limitations.

This SIP submittal to U.S. EPA includes a revised attainment demonstration identifying the additional mill and maintains the strategies deemed necessary to attain the air quality standard by December 31, 2015 incorporated into the 2012 submittal.

The State of Ohio will request that U.S. EPA review and approve the addition of the mill to the list of mills contained in emissions unit P071 in Table 3 of the Attainment Demonstration.

These actions must be noticed to allow public comment and to satisfy U.S. EPA requirements for public involvement in SIP-related activities. Written comments will be received on or before June 24, 2014 at the
