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2 MODERATOR PEELE: The date is January
3 31, 2013. My name is Darla Peele. I'm a public
4 involvement coordinator for Ohio Environmental
5 Protection Agency, Southwest District Office. I
6 will be presiding over today's public hearing.
7 Thank you for taking the time to attend this
8 hearing before Ohio Environmental Protection
9 Agency.

10 The purpose of the hearing today is to
11 obtain comments from any interested person
12 regarding Ohio EPA's proposed action.

13 The State of Ohio is requesting that the
14 U.S. EPA revise the current maintenance plan for
15 the Dayton-Springfield area, which includes
16 Clark, Greene, Miami, and Montgomery Counties,
17 with respect to the 1996 eight-hour ozone
18 national ambient air quality standard.

19 Ohio EPA is now requesting a revision to
20 the maintenance plan to update mobile emission
21 projections and conformity budgets based on
22 emission rates generated from U.S. EPA's latest
23 mobile emissions model, the Motor Vehicle
24 Emissions Simulation 2010. In December 2009

1 MOVES replaced MOBILE6.2 as the U.S. EPA's
2 official emission factor model.

3 All interested persons are entitled to
4 attend or be represented and to present oral
5 and/or written comments concerning the proposed
6 action. All written and oral comments received
7 as a part of the official record will be
8 considered by the Director of Ohio EPA.

9 To be included in the official record,
10 written comments must be received by Ohio EPA by
11 the close of business today, January 31, 2013.
12 The comments may be filed with me today or
13 e-mailed to erica.fetty@epa.ohio.gov.

14 All written comments submitted for the
15 record receive the same consideration as oral
16 testimony given today. Written statements
17 submitted after today may be considered as time
18 and circumstances permit but will not be a part
19 of the official record of the hearing.

20 If you wish to present oral testimony at
21 this hearing today and have not already signed
22 the registration sheet, please do so at this
23 time. The sheet is available at the registration
24 table.

1 Persons will be called in the order in
2 which they have registered. There is no
3 cross-examination of speakers or of
4 representatives of Ohio EPA in public hearings
5 such as this.

6 Ohio EPA hearings such as this afford
7 citizens the opportunity to provide comments on
8 the official record. Therefore, we will not be
9 able to answer questions during the hearing.
10 However, members of the panel may ask
11 clarifying questions of the person testifying to
12 ensure the record is as complete and accurate as
13 possible.

14 I will now go off the record seeing that
15 there are no citizens available who wish to
16 provide testimony. The time is now 3:08 p.m.
