RE: Revocation of Class 2 Water Supply Certificate

Dear Mr. Alatishe:

I am writing with regard to your Class 2 Water Supply Certificate issued to you by Ohio EPA pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Chapter 3745-7. On November 27, 2012, I suspended your Class 2 Water Supply certificate WS2-1109133-08 after you were indicted by the Hamilton County Grand Jury on sixteen counts of tampering with records and one count of theft in Office. These allegations occurred during your employment with the Greater Cincinnati Water Works and involved actions related to certified operator responsibilities.

On October 8, 2013, you pled guilty to four counts of tampering with records and one count of theft in office and on October 23, 2013, you were sentenced to four years of community control, ordered to pay a \$5,000 penalty and to make restitution to the Greater Cincinnati Water Works. Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-7-12(G), conviction of a crime related to the field of certification shall result in suspension of all certificates held by the convicted certified operator until such time as all opportunities for appeal of such conviction have been exhausted, at which point, all certificates held by the certified operator shall be revoked. Due to the fact you have entered a guilty plea and an appeal of your conviction is not anticipated, I am revoking your Class 2 Water Supply certificate WS2-1109133-08.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00, made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio," which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a
