**Public Notice: Proposed 'No Changes' Rulemaking Governing Rules in Chapter 3745-92 of the
Administrative Code, Escrow Requirements.**

Notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Drinking and Ground Waters (DDAGW) is proposing 'no changes' to Chapter 3745-92 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), establishing escrow requirements. The proposed rule filing with 'no changes' is, in part, a result of the five-year rule review requirements of Section 106.031 of the Revised Code. Listed below are the currently effective rules proposed to be filed with no changes.
