A U.S. Environmental Agency (USEPA) Voluntary Program

The USEPA's Safer Choice Program for safer chemical products, formally the Design for the Environment, or "DfE", aims to accomplish the following missions:

- **Communicate the program's human health and environmental protection goals**
- **Increase awareness and recognition of the Safer Choice label on qualifying products**
- **Encourage innovation and the development of safer chemicals and chemical-based products**



As of 2016, the Safer Choice Program is working with 500 innovative partner companies and has qualified more than 2,000 institutional and consumer products – with a broad spectrum of cleaning, home care, and custodial uses – to carry the Safer Choice label.

The Safer Choice label allows purchasers to quickly identify products with safer chemical ingredients that also meet performance standards. Several manufacturers and private label companies within Ohio, such as the ones listed below, have products that meet the rigorous standards of the Safer Choice Program and qualify to carry the Safer Choice label.
