

Down Hole Well Camera

SIFU owns a down-hole well video camera. This cylindrical camera is connected to a spool of coaxial cable and can be lowered into a water well or borehole, producing live video as it is lowered. The camera is used for collecting video data in an effort to support environmental site investigations across the state. It is used to determine integrity of well casings, identify well obstructions or casing warpage and to determine possible contributions from upper to lower water bearing zones. It has real-time viewing capability and can record video.
