RESOLUTION OF INTENT REGARDING THE USE OF THE REPUBLIC STEEL QUARRY SITE ON MUSSEY AVENUE IN THE CITY OF ELYRIA, AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. R99-27, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That in regards to the Republic Steel Quarry site on Mussey Avenue in the City of Elyria, the City of Elyria will make all reasonable efforts to:

- 1) Restrict the use thereof to H-I Heavy Industrial uses only as provided in Part Eleven- Title Five Codified Ordinances of Elyria;
- 2) Prohibit the ground water thereof as a source of drinking water;
- 3) Require the use of City of Elyria municipal water supply as the source of potable water for any industrial or commercial development or public use thereon;
- 4) Post warning signs to keep off the quarry site;
- 5) Maintain in good repair the perimeter fencing thereof;
- 6) Prohibit fishing, swimming and boating in the quarry located therein;
- 7) Prohibit any public access to or use of the quarry, its sediments and the soil thereon
- 8) Conduct and make sufficient inspections to ensure that the above stated controls are in compliance.

SECTION 2: That Resolution No. R99-27, passed by the Council of the City of Elyria on October 4, 1999, be and the same is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with Ohio law.
