## A. GENERAL PERMIT CONDITIONS

### A.1 Effect of Permit

ORC Sections 3734.02 (E) and (F) and 3734.05  
OAC Rule 3745-50-58(G)

- (a) The Permittee is authorized to treat and store hazardous waste in containers and tanks in accordance with the terms and conditions of this permit, ORC Chapter 3734, all applicable Ohio hazardous waste rules, all applicable regulations promulgated under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), as amended, and the approved hazardous waste facility installation and operation permit renewal application, as such application has been revised and supplemented and as such application may be modified pursuant to the hazardous waste rules. The approved Part B permit application as submitted to Ohio EPA on April 2, 1999 and any subsequent amendment thereto, and last updated on ~~January 14, 2003~~ **May 21, 2004** is hereby incorporated into this permit. In the instance of inconsistent language or discrepancies between the above, the language of the more stringent provision shall govern.
- (b) Any management of hazardous waste not authorized by this permit is prohibited, unless otherwise expressly authorized or specifically exempted by law. Issuance of this permit does not convey property rights of any sort or any exclusive privilege; nor does it authorize any injury to persons or property, or invasion of other private rights. Compliance with the terms and conditions of this permit does not obviate Permittee's obligation to comply with other applicable provisions of law governing protection of public health or the environment including but not limited to the Community Right to Know law under ORC Chapter 3750.

### A.2 Permit Actions

OAC Rule 3745-50-58(F)

This permit may be modified, revoked, suspended, or renewed as specified by Ohio law. The filing of a request for a permit modification, revision, revocation, suspension, or renewal or the notification of planned changes or anticipated noncompliance on the part of the Permittee, does not stay the applicability or enforceability of any permit term or condition.
