

PERMIT SUMMARY

This is a Final Permit to Install (PTI Number 726880) to increase the authorized maximum daily waste receipt (AMDWR) of the Sunny Farms Landfill, LLC (Facility) located on West County Road 18 in Loudon Township, Seneca County from 3,000 tons to 5,000 tons. The previous AMDWR was established by PTI Number 03-16056, issued February 20, 2004.

Based on the AMDWR of 5,000 tons, the total facility airspace will provide an estimated facility life of 2.9 years. However, based on the facility's average anticipated gate receipts of 4,000 tons, the estimated life of the facility will be approximately 3.7 years.

The above summary is provided solely for informational purposes and does not constitute a part of, or otherwise affect, the attached permit-to-install.

PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. The director, or an authorized representative, may enter upon the premises of the above-named permittee at any reasonable time during construction and operation for the purpose of making inspections, conducting tests, or examining records or reports pertaining to the construction, modification, or installation of the above described source of environmental pollutants (municipal solid waste disposal facility).
2. The Facility's AMDWR is hereby established to be 5,000 tons. This supersedes any previously established AMDWR for the Facility. This approval shall only apply to the increase in the Facility's AMDWR.
3. The permittee shall not accept more than 5,000 tons of waste per day for disposal at the Facility. This tonnage includes both solid waste and exempt waste, including, but not limited to, construction and demolition debris.
4. Issuance of this permit approval does not relieve the permittee of the duty to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, and regulations.
5. This permit approval may be modified, or alternatively revoked and reissued, to comply with any revisions to OAC Chapter 3745-27 applicable to this municipal solid waste disposal facility.
6. The permittee shall provide for the proper maintenance and operation of the municipal solid waste disposal facility in accordance with the provisions of OAC Chapter 3745-27.

7. Nothing in this permit approval shall be construed to authorize any waiver from the requirements of any applicable federal or state laws or regulations. This permit approval shall not be interpreted to release the permittee from responsibility under Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111; under the Federal Clean Water Act, the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, or the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act; or from other applicable requirements for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.
8. This permit approval does not authorize the acceptance of any hazardous or infectious wastes, except for those excluded from hazardous or infectious waste regulation by ORC Chapter 3734.
9. This permit approval does not authorize the acceptance of any asbestos or asbestos-containing waste material that is subject to the provisions of NESHAP, 40 CFR Part 61, Subpart M. No such asbestos-containing waste material may be accepted without first obtaining the necessary permits from Ohio EPA.
10. To the extent that this permit approval specifies requirements different from or in addition to previous solid waste permits issued for the Facility, the terms and conditions contained herein shall take precedence over any conflicting requirements.
