**Re: SUBURBAN RECYCLING & DISPOSAL FACILITY, NORTH; LICKING COUNTY
PROPOSED CHANGES TO ALTERNATE PARAMETER LIST AND SAMPLING
SEQUENCE FOR LOW-YIELD MONITORING WELLS**

Dear Ms. Robinson:

On April 5, 2010, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Solid and Infectious Waste Management (DSIWM), Central District Office (CDO), received a request to modify the 1995 alternate parameter list and sampling sequence for low-yield monitoring wells, for the Suburban Recycling and Disposal Facility (RDF), North, in Licking County. This request was submitted by Waste Management of Ohio.

The request proposes to substitute potassium for COD as a sampling parameter in low-yield wells and to change the sampling sequence to VOCs, ammonia, chloride, sodium, potassium and field parameters.

Ohio EPA, Division of Drinking and Ground Waters (DDAGWs) has reviewed the request per Ohio Administrative Code Rule 2745-27-10 (D)(4) and recommends the proposed changes be accepted. Therefore, pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D)(4), Waste Management of Ohio is authorized to substitute potassium for COD and to change the sampling sequence for parameters analyzed at their low-yield wells.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00, made payable to "Ohio Treasurer Kevin Boyce," which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. An appeal may be filed with the Environmental Review Appeals Commission at the following address:
