**Re: Suburban Landfill, Perry County
Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g) Approval**

Dear Mr. Fello:

On October 5, 2010, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Solid and Infectious Waste Management (DSIWM), Southeast District Office (SEDO), received a document titled Statistical Analysis Program for Ground Water Monitoring (Revision 4) OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g), dated October 1, 2010, for the Suburban Landfill (Facility) located in Perry County. This document was submitted by Eagon & Associates on behalf of Waste Management, pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g), and requested approval from the director to incorporate statistical exceedances at well P-107C for chloride and potassium and at well P-117C for potassium into the background observation period.

The October 1 document submitted by Eagon & Associates indicates that well P-107C had six exceedances for chloride and potassium and that well P-117C had eight exceedances for potassium during the observation period. These statistical exceedances were demonstrated to be due to natural variation in ground water quality in a submittal dated April 12, 2010. Ohio EPA concurred with that demonstration that the referenced results were due to natural variation in ground water quality and were not the result of impacts from the Facility in correspondence dated August 17, 2010.

Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g), the owner/operator is hereby authorized to include the results for chloride and potassium into the background period for well P-107C and for potassium for well P-117C as referenced on Page 15 of the Statistical Analysis Program for Ground Water Monitoring (Revision 4) OAC Rule 3745-27-10 (C)(7) (g), dated October 1, 2010, for Suburban Landfill located in Perry County. Subsequent statistical analysis should be performed as described within the October 1, 2010, Statistical Analysis Program.


**SUBURBAN LANDFILL

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You are hereby notified that this action of the director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00, made payable to "Ohio Treasurer Kevin Boyce," which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section.
