

PUBLIC NOTICE
PROPOSED CONSENT ORDER

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) and Cardington Yutaka Technologies, Inc. ("CYT") have entered into a proposed Consent Order, Case Number 2012 CV 0043. The proposed Consent Order would require CYT to immediately comply with the requirements of Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111 by completing permit to install applications, completing an environmental audit, making available records of waste shipped offsite, installing and maintaining flow meters, and applying for an indirect discharge permit or an NPDES permit. CYT is an auto-parts manufacturing facility located at 575 West Main Street, Cardington, Morrow County, Ohio.

The proposed Consent Order also requires CYT to pay a five hundred thousand dollar (\$500,000) civil penalty.

Written comments should be submitted to Ohio EPA, Central District Office at the above address. Written comments should be submitted on or before January 9, 2013.

The final approval and entry of the proposed Consent Order will not occur until after the thirty (30) day public comment period has expired. The thirty day period commences on December 10, 2012. Both the State of Ohio and CYT reserve the right to withdraw or alter the proposed Consent Order based on comments received during the public comment period.
