The Division of Surface Water (DSW) is providing interested parties opportunity to review and comment on the following rules in Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Chapter 3745-1:

The draft revisions the Agency is considering are updates to beneficial use designations, including: changing beneficial use designations for specific water bodies, adding water bodies that are currently undesignated to the rules and verifying existing beneficial use designations already listed in the rules. In addition to the draft rule amendments, Ohio EPA is also seeking comments and feedback on the draft Common Sense Initiative (CSI) Business Impact Analysis Form, which is being released with these rules for review.
