### **Topics Covered:**

This hands-on workshop focuses on conducting storm water inspections on construction sites. Participants will learn to read and interpret storm water pollution prevention plans (SWP3s) and assess construction site runoff controls for compliance with NPDES and local storm water program requirements. Participants will be led by staff from Ohio EPA, Cuyahoga SWCD, Summit SWCD and Geauga SWCD. Participants will also get the chance to conduct a mock inspection on their own.

Participants will meet at Liberty Park and take buses from there to five different construction sites in Cuyahoga and Summit Counties. These sites are:

The intended audience for this workshop is field staff that conducts compliance inspections for storm water best management practices (BMPs) on construction sites for local MS4 programs.
