3 McCarron. I'm a public information officer for
4 Ohio EPA. Thanks for taking the time to come to
5 the hearing.

6 The purpose of the hearing today is to
7 obtain comments from any interested person
8 regarding Ohio EPA's proposed action. Ohio EPA
9 is submitting to U.S. EPA the Infrastructure
10 State Implementation Plan for the State of Ohio
11 to comply with the 2008 Lead guidance from U.S.
12 EPA.

17 me today at today's hearing.

18 All interested persons are entitled to
19 attend or be represented and to present oral
20 and/or written comments concerning the proposed
21 action. All written and oral comments received
22 as part of the official record will be considered
23 by the director of Ohio EPA prior to being
24 submitted to U.S. EPA. Written statements

1 submitted after the comment period closes may be
2 considered as time and circumstances permit, but
3 they won't be part of the official record.

4 If you wish to present testimony, I'm
5 going to call folks up in the order they signed
6 in on the sign-in sheet. If you don't want to

7 speak or provide comments, just go ahead and say,
8 "Pass."

9 There's no cross-examination of speakers
10 or representatives of Ohio EPA in public hearings
11 such as this. Ohio EPA hearings provide citizens
12 an opportunity to submit comments on the official
13 record. Therefore, we won't be able to answer
14 questions during the hearing. But Ohio EPA staff
15 may ask you clarifying questions to make sure
16 your testimony is as complete and accurate as
17 possible.

18 I'll read the names of those who have
19 signed in. Again, if you don't want to say
20 anything, go ahead and say, "Pass."
