

RULE SYNOPSIS

Draft rule language for Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-109, “Clean Air Interstate Rule”, Five – year review

The Ohio EPA Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) completed draft rule language for the incorporation of minor revisions in Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Chapter 3745-109, “Clean Air Interstate Rule”, as required by Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 119.032 (Five-year review). DAPC has determined that all of the rules in this chapter are still necessary and require amendments as follows.

Changes made as a result of draft review:

These rules were available for public comment for a period of 30 days, beginning on April 17, 2013. DAPC received one set of comments. After a review of these comments, DAPC has decided to continue with the scope of the rule as drafted and made no changes to the original draft rules as a result of outside comments.

Original draft changes presented for comment in April 17, 2013 draft:

DAPC is not recommending any changes to the scope or intent of the rules and most of the draft amendments were minor in nature, primarily for clarification, formatting and typographical corrections.

Summary of revisions beyond those for clarification, formatting, and typographical for Chapter 3745-109, 5-year review:

1. OAC rule 3745-109-01 (Definitions); Paragraphs (H), (H)(1), and (H)(2) of this rule have been revised to incorporate updated Referenced materials language.
2. OAC rule 3745-109-03 (Permits); Title changed from “Permits” to “CAIR NO_x source permits.”
3. OAC rule 3745-109-07 (Monitoring and reporting); Title changed from “Monitoring and reporting” to “CAIR NO_x unit monitoring and reporting.”
4. OAC rule 3745-109-10 (Permits); Title changed from “Permits” to “CAIR SO₂ source permits.”
5. OAC rule 3745-109-13 (Monitoring and reporting); Title changed from “Monitoring and reporting” to “CAIR SO₂ unit monitoring and reporting.”
6. OAC rule 3745-109-16 (Permits); Title changed from “Permits” to “CAIR NO_x ozone season source permits.”

7. OAC rule 3745-109-20 (Monitoring and reporting); Title changed from “Monitoring and reporting” to “CAIR NOx ozone season unit monitoring and reporting.”

Titles for those rules pertaining to permitting, monitoring, and reporting requirements were changed to reflect the particular source category and regulatory period for the purposes of clarity.
