

## **RULE SYNOPSIS**

### Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Chapter 3745-23, "Nitrogen Oxide Standards" Discussion of Amendments for 5-Year Rule Review

The rules in Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Chapter 3745-23 contain requirements for how Ohio EPA will monitor for Nitrogen Oxides as part of Ohio's State Implementation Plan (SIP) for the attainment and attainment of the national ambient air quality standard (NAAQS).

The changes to these rules are minor and primarily administrative in nature. The changes are as follows:

#### OAC Rule 3745-23-01, "Definitions"

Changes were made to the various subparagraphs under paragraph (C) of this rule. These items give information on the version and availability of materials referenced in this Chapter as required by Ohio Revised Code 121.72. The information was updated to include more reliable website references for electronic retrieval of materials and updates were made to items under paragraph (C)(2) to ensure that the most recent versions of the materials was referenced.

#### OAC Rule 3745-23-02, "Methods of Measurement"

A change was made to clarify the intro paragraph of the rule and bring the paragraph in line with LSC formatting conventions.. The paragraph has been modified to point the rule citation at paragraph (C) of OAC rule 3745-23-01 instead of the generic "last paragraph" reference.
