

EP-30-03 Permit to Install Exemptions.

(A) A Permit to Install as required by EP-30-02 must be obtained for installation of

SECRETARY OF STATE

(1) a new source of air pollutants other than

PER     

- (a) a fuel fired indirect heat exchanger which burns fuel oil or natural gas to produce steam, hot water, or hot air and which has an input capacity of less than 1,000,000 BTU per hour at maximum rating; or
  - (b) storage for photochemically reactive materials in tanks of less than 500 gallon capacity; or
  - (c) an operation or process limited to the use of materials
    - (1) whose volatile content consists only of water and liquid organic material, and
    - (2) the liquid organic material is not more than 20% by volume of the total volume, and
    - (3) the volatile content is not a photochemically reactive material; or
  - (d) a source that uses liquid organic materials which exhibit a vapor pressure of less than .5 mm Hg absolute at 220°F; or
  - (e) an incinerator serving no more than 5 households, or
  - (f) equipment used for spraying or other employment of insecticides, pesticides, or herbicides; or
  - (g) any other source of air pollutants of small emission significance that the Director has by order exempted from the requirements of EP-30-02.
- (2) a new source treatment works intended to receive wastewater that contains
- (a) wastes other than sewage, or
  - (b) sewage in amounts more than 5,000 gallons per day or more than 50 pounds per day of Biochemical Oxygen Demand (BOD<sub>5</sub>); or
- (3) a new solid waste disposal facility.

- (B) No permit to Install need be obtained for modification of a source of air pollutants or a treatment works if after modification the source of air pollutants or the treatment works will be of a type that could have been installed without a permit.
- (C) No permit to install need be obtained for modification of a source of air pollutants or a treatment works if the impact of the modification on environmental quality is so slight that the Director has by order exempted the modification from the requirements of EP-30-02.
- (D) Exemption from the requirement that a Permit to Install be obtained shall not exempt any person from compliance with any other applicable laws.

(Former regulations AP-9-01 and AP-9-02, adopted July 24, 1972, and effective August 7, 1972, are repealed.)
