

EP-30-06 Termination of Permit to Install.

(A) A Permit to Install shall terminate if:

- (1) detail plans of the source of air pollutants, treatment works, or solid waste disposal facility, if required, are not submitted to the Ohio EPA for approval within one year of the effective date of the Permit to Install, or
- (2) the owner or operator has not undertaken a continuing program of installation or modification or has not entered into a binding contractual obligation to undertake and complete within a reasonable time a continuing program of installation or modification in accordance with approved detail plans, if required, within 18 months of the effective date of the Permit to Install, or within six months of approval of detail plans, whichever is later.

(B) The Director may extend these dates of expiration by up to 12 months if the applicant submits, not less than 60 days before the expiration date, information that, in the judgment of the Director, adequately justifies an extension of time. No appeal taken from denial of extension of an expiration date shall prevent termination of a permit during the period between denial of extension and final disposition of the appeal.
