

Public Notice – Request for Comment
Draft New and Amended Rules
OAC Rules 3750-10-08 and 3750-30-27

Notice is hereby given that, on behalf of the co-chairs of the State Emergency Response Commission (SERC), the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) has amended OAC 3750-30-27 to incorporate federal reporting language and drafted proposed new rule OAC 3750-10-08 that establishes a mechanism for Local Emergency Planning Committees (LEPCs) to designate a facility to be subject to their local plan.

As part of the rule-making process, DAPC and the SERC are required by Section 121.39 of the Ohio Revised Code to consult with organizations that represent political subdivisions, environmental interests, business interests, and others affected by the rules. The DAPC is offering your organization the opportunity to comment on these rules before the division formally proposes them.
