Rule Synopsis

Ohio EPA, on behalf of the State Emergency Response Commission, has completed a review of rule in Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) section 3750. This review also serves as the fulfillment of the 5-year review for OAC 3750-30-27 under ORC 106.03.

Amended

OAC 3750-30-27, "Threshold Quantity for Hazardous Chemical Reporting". The rule was amended to incorporate federal EPA reporting language to clarify the requirement to aggregate extremely hazardous substances (EHS's) in mixtures. The SERC rule did not make this distinction between required aggregation of EHSs and optional aggregation of non-EHS hazardous chemicals. The language provided in amended rule is consistent with federal Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know regulations, 40 CFR, Section 370.28. The federal language was added verbatim at the end of the rule OAC 3750-30-27(E) (3).

New

OAC 3750-10-08, "Request for Order from a Local Emergency Planning Committee." The proposed new rule establishes a mechanism for a Local Emergency Planning Committee to get designated a facility to be subject to their local plan.
