The permittee shall maintain freeboard ratio of 1.0 or greater, center of chilled air blanket no greater than 30% of solvent's boiling point, and reduced room draft with flow or movement of air within the solvent cleaning machine enclosure not to exceed 15.2 meters per minute (50 feet per minute). Misc - The OR, M, R, Rp, and ET supersede the requirements in PTI.
