Dear Mr. Oliver:

CNC Metal Products (CNC) public water system (PWS) has violated Ohio's safe drinking water laws. Specifically, CNC failed to monitor routinely for total coliform bacteria, failed to collect five routine total coliform samples in the month following a total coliform positive result, failed to collect four repeat samples following a total coliform positive routine sample within 24 hours, exceeded the monthly maximum contaminant level for total coliform when more than one sample was positive during the month, failed to submit detail plans of the existing well and treatment equipment, failed to submit a Corrosion Control Recommendation when the lead action level was exceeded, and failed to provide public notification for these violations.

**Owners or operators of public water systems that fail to comply with Ohio's safe drinking water laws and regulations are subject to civil penalties of up to \$25,000 per day per violation under Ohio Revised Code Section 6109.33.**

To resolve your drinking water violations and avoid possible legal action and civil penalties:

- 1) Monitor for total coliform bacteria with a minimum of one routine sample per calendar quarter from the distribution system and perform any required repeat monitoring, in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-81-21.
- 2) Comply with the monitoring and reporting requirements in accordance with the 2006 and 2007 chemical monitoring schedules.
- 3) By November 8, 2006, post public notices for past total coliform monitoring violations for no less than seven (7) days in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-81-32. Send the public notices and verification forms to Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Northeast District Office (NEDO), Division of Drinking and Ground Waters, Attn: Beth Madis, 2110 East Aurora Road, Twinsburg, Ohio 44087. A public notice and verification form that can

be used to cover these violations has been included as an attachment to this letter.

- 4) By November 8, 2006, provide Ohio EPA, NEDO, with an updated written sample siting plan, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-81-21(A).
- 5) <sup>EC</sup> By ~~November 15~~ <sup>December 31</sup>, 2006, submit a Corrosion Control Recommendation as required by OAC Rule 3745-81-80(C)(1).
- 6) By December 31, 2006, submit as-built detail plans for the well and existing water treatment equipment for Ohio EPA approval. As a part of detail plan submission, a set of complete raw (prior to treatment) water analyses will need to be conducted, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-9-09. The plans should illustrate a contingency for corrosion control treatment should CNC exceed the lead action level in the future.
- 7) Within thirty (30) days of notification, respond in writing to address any comments or deficiencies noted by Ohio EPA on any plan or documentation submitted.
- 8) By January 1, 2007, CNC will hire or retain a certified operator holding at least a Class A license to be in responsible charge of your PWS, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-7-02(A)(1).
