PREAMBLE

It is agreed by the Parties hereto as follows:

I. JURISDICTION

These Director's Findings and Orders (Orders) are issued to Charles E. Medley (Respondent) pursuant to the authority vested in the Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) under Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapters 6109 and 6111 and § 3745.01.

II. PARTIES BOUND

These Orders shall apply to and be binding upon Respondent.

III. DEFINITIONS

Unless otherwise stated, all terms used in these Orders shall have the same meaning as defined in ORC Chapters 6109 and 6111 and the rules promulgated thereunder.

IV. FINDINGS

The Director of Ohio EPA has determined the following findings:

1. Respondent holds a Class III Water Supply Certificate, number WS3-1006797-90. Respondent also holds a Class II Wastewater Treatment Certificate, number WW2-1006797-91.
2. Respondent was the operator of record for the Village of Bethesda public water system (PWS) and wastewater treatment plant (WWTP).

3. In accordance with OAC Rule 3745-7-12(A)(2), version effective until December 20, 2006, the director may suspend or revoke the certification of an operator upon finding that the operator has performed the duties of an operator in a grossly negligent or incompetent manner.
4. In accordance with OAC Rule 3745-7-12(A)(3), version effective until December 20, 2006, the director may suspend or revoke the certification of an operator upon finding the operator knowingly or negligently submitted misleading, inaccurate, or false reports.
5. In accordance with OAC Rule 3745-7-12(A)(4), version effective until December 20, 2006, the director may suspend or revoke the certification of an operator upon finding that the operator has operated in a manner endangering the public health or welfare.
6. In accordance with OAC Rule 3745-7-12(A)(5), version effective until December 20, 2006, the director may suspend or revoke the certification of an operator upon finding that the operator has operated in such a manner to have violated or caused to be violated any provisions of ORC Chapters 6109 or 6111.
7. Respondent pled guilty to one felony count of falsifying information to the Ohio EPA on November 29, 2007. Respondent admitted to falsifying monthly operating reports (MORs) for the months of June, July and August of 2006. The chlorinator at the WWTP was broken from October 2005 to September 2006.
8. Respondent failed to obtain fecal coliform samples during the months of June, July and August of 2006.
9. Respondent reported false values for fecal coliform samples on the June, July and August of 2006 MORs.
10. Respondent's actions constitute the performance of his duties as an operator in a negligent or incompetent manner.
11. Respondent's actions constitute the knowing or negligent submission of misleading, inaccurate, or false reports.
12. Respondent's actions endangered the public health and welfare.
13. Respondent's actions constitute a violation of ORC Chapter 6111.
14. Each violation cited above represents a separate violation of ORC § 6109.31 and 6111.46.

#### **V. ORDERS**

1. Upon the effective date of these Orders, Respondent's Class III Water Supply Certificate, number WS3-1006797-90 and Class II Wastewater Treatment Certificate, number WW2-1006797-91 are revoked for a period of seven (7) years.
2. Within ten (10) days of the effective date of these Orders, Respondent shall return his Class III Water Supply and Class II Wastewater Treatment certificates in accordance with the provisions in Paragraph X below.

#### **VI. TERMINATION**

Respondent's obligations under these Orders shall terminate upon the submission of his Class III Water Supply and Class II Wastewater Treatment certificates in accordance with Paragraph X below.

#### **VII. OTHER CLAIMS**

Nothing in these Orders shall constitute or be construed as a release from any claim, cause of action or demand in law or equity against any person, firm, partnership or corporation, not a party to these Orders, for any liability arising from, or related to the Respondent's a public water system or treatment works.

#### **VIII. OTHER APPLICABLE LAWS**

All actions required to be taken pursuant to these Orders shall be undertaken in accordance with the requirements of all applicable local, state and federal laws and regulations. These Orders do not waive or compromise the applicability and enforcement of any other statutes or regulations applicable to Respondent.

#### **IX. MODIFICATIONS**

These Orders may be modified by agreement of the Parties. Modifications shall be in writing and shall be effective on the date entered in the journal of the Director of Ohio EPA.

## **X. NOTICE**

## **XI. RESERVATION OF RIGHTS**

Ohio EPA and Respondent each reserve all rights, privileges and causes of action, except as specifically waived in Section XII of these Orders.

## **XII. WAIVER**

In order to resolve disputed claims, without admission of fact, violation or liability, and in lieu of further enforcement action by Ohio EPA for only the violations specifically cited in these Orders. Respondent consents to the issuance of these Orders and agrees to comply with these Orders. Except for the right to seek civil or administrative penalties against Respondent for violations specifically cited in these Orders, which Ohio EPA does not waive, compliance with these Orders shall be a full accord and satisfaction for Respondent's liability for the violations specifically cited herein.

Respondent hereby waives the right to appeal the issuance, terms and conditions, and service of these Orders, and Respondent hereby waives any and all rights Respondent may have to seek administrative or judicial review of these Orders either in law or equity.

Notwithstanding the preceding, Ohio EPA and Respondent agree that if these Orders are appealed by any other party to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission, or any court, Respondent retains the right to intervene and participate in such appeal. In such an event, Respondent shall continue to comply with these Orders notwithstanding such appeal and intervention unless these Orders are stayed, vacated or modified.

**XIII. EFFECTIVE DATE**

The effective date of these Orders is the date these Orders are entered into the Ohio EPA Director's journal.


**XIV. SIGNATORY AUTHORITY**


