The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency's purpose is to maintain a safe and healthy environment for the population of Ohio. To support the goals of the Utility Radiological Safety Board (URSB), the Ohio EPA Radiological Safety Program collects and monitors performance trends of monthly, annual, and special operating reports on air, water, and hazardous waste generation from the nuclear plants. A synopsis is presented to the URSB on a quarterly basis. The Agency has one full time staff Health Physicist and twenty-five other employees who devote a portion of their time to the activities supported by the Board and for emergencies. Each one contributes their particular expertise to the work of the Board, as it is needed.
