Clean Ohio/Jobs Ohio Fund-Finalized Grant Agreements

Projects have been approved via the Jobs Ohio, ODSA/OEPA application criteria and have received Controlling Board approval (i.e. grant agreements finalized) for the following sites:

- **True Steel** (former Tru Temper Site) – Geneva (Ashtabula Co)- \$338,455 for Cleanup. Arthur Lewis Steel has purchased property and will redevelop site as a steel fabrication facility
- **Scrap** (former RG Steel Site) – Steubenville - \$1 Million for Cleanup. Strauss Company has purchased and will redevelop the site for materials handling and logistics for the oil and gas industry

Clean Ohio/Jobs Ohio Fund – Finalized Grant Agreements (con't)

- **Clean Mineral Site**, Columbiana County (leased by Seaforth Mineral and Oil-Columbiana Port Authority Applicant) - \$182,906 for Phase II Assessment. Seaforth currently conducts dry materials handling at the facility and is assessing the ability to expand their operations to include large quantity liquid handling operations.
- **Plate Site** (former Dayton Electroplate – City of Dayton Applicant) -\$195, 654 for Phase II Assessment. End use of site is (purchase/lease) to Children's Medical Center for expansion.

Clean Ohio/Jobs Ohio Fund Projects- Controlling Board Approval Pending

- **Clean Agriculture** (Richland County) City of Mansfield - Applicant - \$1,000,000 for Cleanup. End use of site is bulk fertilizer distribution company. Controlling Board Hearing scheduled for 7/22/13.
- **Temple Site** (former Remington Kardex Systems Facility in Marietta) Southeastern Port Authority – Applicant - \$200,000 for Phase II Assessment. End use of site is housing and retail development. Controlling Board Hearing scheduled for 7/22/13.

Seven other projects have received Jobs Ohio Grant Funding Approval and are currently going through the ODSA/OEPA application process:

- Sterling Conveyor Site (Mt. Sterling)- \$67,000 for Phase II (??- may not accept grant)
- Former Republic Steel (Canton)-\$200,000 for Phase II
- Fortuna Construction Co.(Cleveland)- \$550,000 for Cleanup
- Former RG Steel (Yorkville) - \$1 Million for Cleanup
- Eden Park Pump Station (Cincinnati)-\$730,000 for Cleanup
- Trautman Hub (Columbus) - \$1,000,000 for Cleanup
- Clean Alliance (City of Alliance) - \$1,275,000 for Cleanup

Tentative CORF Application Schedule and Clean Ohio Council Meeting

- August 7, 2013 – CORF Applications due in public library
- Between September 23– September 25, 2013 - Hold Application public meetings
- September 26, 2013 – Submit Applications to Integrating Committees (ICs)
- October 3, 2013 - ICs submit Applications to ODSA
- October 7 – October 18, 2013 Application Cure Period
- October 25, 2013 – Application Summaries and additional CORF Information submitted to COC Members (COC Members Briefed between October 28 and 31, 2013)
- November 1, 2013 – Clean Ohio Council Meeting
