US EPA – ARC Grants

- U.S. EPA plans to announce the FFY13 Round for Assessment, Revolving Loan Fund and Cleanup Grants this Fall.
- Approximately \$50 Million will be available nationwide
- Additional emphasis is expected to be placed on funding small and rural community projects



New Jobs Ohio Fund

- Announcement expected at the November 1 Clean Ohio Counsel Meeting
- JobsOhio, given its privatized nature, will be able to provide fast and efficient customer service in order to ensure job creation and retention in Ohio
- Jobs Ohio is expected to continue to work with its Network Partners to administer this funding program
