

PUBLIC NOTICE
Ohio EPA Director Issues
Final Findings and Orders for
Former Elano Corporation Sites, Dayton, Ohio

On September 2nd, 2014, the Director of Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) issued as a final action Director's Final Findings and Orders to the General Electric Company of Fairfield, CT to implement an Interim Action at the Former Elano Corporation Sites (Sites), located at 2455 Dayton-Xenia Road and 530 Orchard Lane, Dayton, Ohio. The Director's Final Findings and Orders require the following actions: assess potential vapor intrusion into buildings near the Sites; design and install mitigation systems at any building that is identified as needing vapor intrusion mitigation due to unacceptable vapor exposure; and pay Ohio EPA's past and future oversight costs for the Sites.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00, made payable to "Ohio Treasurer," which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. An appeal may be filed with the Environmental Review Appeals Commission at the Environmental Review Appeals Commission, 77 South High Street, 17th Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
