**Used oil specifications.**

Used oil burned for energy recovery, and any fuel produced from used oil by processing, blending, or other treatment, is subject to regulation under Chapter 3745-279 of the Administrative Code unless it is shown not to exceed any of the allowable levels of the constituents and properties ~~in the specification shown in table 1 of the table in~~ shown in this rule. Once used oil that is to be burned for energy recovery has been shown not to exceed any ~~specification allowable level~~, and the person making that showing complies with rules 3745-279-72, 3745-279-73, and paragraphs (B) and (C) of rule 3745-279-74 of the Administrative Code, the used oil is no longer subject to Chapter 3745-279 of the Administrative Code.

**Table 1: Used Oil Not Exceeding Any ~~Specification~~ Allowable Level Shown In This Table Is Not Subject to Chapter 3745-279 of the Administrative Code When Burned for Energy Recovery<sup>1</sup>**

Constituent/property	Allowable level
Arsenic	5 ppm maximum
Cadmium	2 ppm maximum
Chromium	10 ppm maximum
Lead	100 ppm maximum
Flash point	100 °F minimum
Total halogens	4,000 ppm maximum <sup>2</sup>

<sup>1</sup> The ~~specification does~~ allowable levels do not apply to mixtures of used oil and hazardous waste that continue to be regulated as hazardous waste [see paragraph (B) of rule 3745-279-10 of the Administrative Code].

<sup>2</sup> Used oil containing more than one thousand parts per million (ppm) total halogens is presumed to be a hazardous waste under the rebuttable presumption provided under paragraph (B)(1) of rule 3745-279-10 of the Administrative Code. Such used oil is subject to rules 3745-266-100 to 3745-266-112 of the Administrative Code rather than Chapter 3745-279 of the Administrative Code when burned for energy recovery unless the presumption of mixing can be successfully rebutted.

[**Note Comment** 1: Applicable standards for the burning of used oil containing polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) are imposed by 40 CFR 761.20(e).]
