Dear Mr. Simcic:

On August 30, 2013, Ohio EPA issued Hukill Chemical Corporation's (Hukill) a permit modification to transfer Hukill's hazardous waste facility installation and operation permit (Permit) to TIER Environmental, LLC (TIER). TIER is purchasing Hukill and will continue to operate the hazardous waste storage and treatment facility. It is the recommendation of the staff that the Director issue the draft Permit modification since the proposed modification to the Permit appears to comply with applicable hazardous waste rules. Therefore, I have enclosed the draft Permit modification in accordance with Rule 3745-50-51 of the Ohio Administrative Code.

A public notice concerning the issuance of the Class 3 Draft Permit Modification will appear in The Plain Dealer newspaper on September 5, 2013. Ohio EPA will accept written comments relevant to the draft Permit modification until October 21, 2013. Written comments and/or requests to hold a public meeting should be submitted before the close of the public comment period on October 21, 2013, to Ohio EPA, Division of Materials and Waste Management, Authorizing Actions and Engineering Unit, P.O. 

CLASS 3 HAZARDOUS WASTE DRAFT PERMIT MODIFICATION

On August 30, 2013, the director of Ohio EPA, pursuant and subject to 3734-05(I) of the Ohio Revised Code and Rule 3745-50-51(D) of the Ohio Administrative Code, issued a draft Modified Ohio Hazardous Waste Facility Installation and Operation Permit to Hukill Chemical Corporation (Hukill), 7013 Krick Road, Bedford, Ohio 44146, Ohio EPA ID number OHD001926740. On April 15, 2013, Hukill submitted a Class 3 modification application to transfer Hukill's hazardous waste facility installation and operation permit to TIER Environmental, LLC (TIER). TIER is purchasing Hukill and will continue to operate the hazardous waste storage and treatment facility. Hukill operates a hazardous waste storage and treatment facility and is engaged in solvent recycling and fuel blending activities. To issue this draft permit modification, Ohio EPA determined that the Permit application is complete and meets appropriate standards and that TIER has a history of compliance with relevant environmental laws and demonstrates sufficient reliability, expertise and competency to operate a hazardous waste facility. What is the history of the hazardous waste program?

The Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), an amendment to the Solid Waste Disposal Act, was passed in 1976. The main reason for the amendment was to

address the growing volume of municipal and industrial solid waste generated across the United States. A few goals established by RCRA include the protection of human health and the environment from potential hazards of waste disposal, to reduce the amount of waste generated and to ensure that waste produced is managed in an environmentally sound manner.

When RCRA was written, U.S. Congress' intent for the states was to assume primary responsibility for implementing the hazardous waste regulations with oversight from the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA). U.S. EPA must approve each state as an authorized state. To become an authorized state, each must demonstrate that the state programs are at least equivalent to and consistent with federal laws, provide adequate enforcement authority and provide availability of information similar to the federal program. Since 1989, the State of Ohio has been an authorized state by U.S. EPA for the majority of the hazardous waste program.

How can I become more involved?

All persons, including the applicant, may submit written comments relating to this draft action. Written comments or requests for a public meeting may be submitted before the end of the comment period to the address in the box on the left.

The comment period begins on September 5, 2013, and ends on October 21, 2013. A copy of the permit application and the draft permit is available for review by the public at the following locations:

The Ohio draft modified permit is available for review by the public online under the "Stakeholder Input" tab at: epa.ohio.gov/dmwm/.

After the close of the public comment period, Ohio EPA will, without prior hearing, issue a modified permit (or deny the request) in accordance with Chapter 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC). If Ohio EPA approves the application, taking into account public comments, a modified permit will be issued with terms and conditions as are necessary to ensure compliance with hazardous waste rules.

What does the facility do?

Hukill Chemical Corporation operates a hazardous waste storage and treatment facility and is engaged in solvent recycling and fuel blending activities.

What is the purpose of this permit modification?

Transfer of the hazardous waste facility installation and operation permit from Hukill Chemical Corporation to TIER Environmental, LLC. TIER Environmental is purchasing Hukill Chemical Corporation and will continue to operate the hazardous waste storage and treatment facility.

What is the regulatory basis to support this permit modification?

When applying for a Class 3 permit modification, an applicant, Hukill Chemical Corporation, is required by OAC Rule 3745-50-51(D) to submit the relevant informational requirements of OAC Rule 3745-50-43 (Part A application contents) and OAC Rule 3745-50-44 (Part B application contents). Hukill Chemical Corporation submitted the Class 3 modification application with the relevant required information on April 15, 2013. Ohio EPA has reviewed the application and has determined that the proposal complies with Ohio EPA rules. Accordingly, Ohio EPA is issuing a draft action indicating the director's intention with respect to the issuance of a modified permit to Hukill Chemical Corporation.

The Ohio Hazardous Waste Facility Installation and Operation Permit with the above-referenced permit number as issued by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and journalized on December 28, 2006, is hereby incorporated by reference in its entirety, except as it may be modified herein.

This modification of the permit shall remain in effect until such time as the Ohio Hazardous Waste Facility Installation and Operation Permit is renewed, modified, withdrawn, suspended, or revoked.

The Permittee shall comply with all requirements of the modified Part B permit application as amended or supplemented on April 15, 2013 and July 17, 2013. The information contained in the modified Part B permit application is incorporated herein by reference. Specifically, all written statements regarding the specifications, locations, or capabilities of the processes, equipment, containment devices, safety devices or programs, or other matters made by the applicant in the permit modification application are hereby incorporated as express, binding terms and conditions of this modified permit.

The modified Terms and Conditions of this permit are attached hereto and are incorporated herein by reference. The modified Terms and Conditions supersede and replace the corresponding pages found in the December 28, 2006 renewal permit.
