Dear Mr. Lear:

On September 20, 2005, Ohio EPA received Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc.'s request for the 1) installation of new piezometers, monitoring wells, and stream gauges within sixty (60) days of approval of this modification; 2) designation of wells to be sampled for a modified list of appendix to OAC Rule 3475-54-98 constituents within sixty (60) days of approval to better define the chemicals of concern at the site, and; 3) specification of followup activities Safety-Kleen will take based on the data obtained. For this modification, Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc., submitted a Class 2 modification application<sup>1</sup>. The Agency did not receive any verbal or written comments concerning this Class 2 modification. I have enclosed the final modified Ohio hazardous waste facility installation and operation permit (Permit) that was issued by the director today. Please note that the modified Permit remains in effect until it is renewed, withdrawn, suspended or revoked.

You have the right to appeal this Permit decision to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (ERAC) no later than 30 days after the public notice (See Ohio Revised Code § 3745.04). You may file your appeal with ERAC at the following address: Environmental Review Appeals Commission, 309 South Fourth Street, Room 222, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

If you file an appeal, you must put it in writing. Your appeal must explain why you are appealing the action and the grounds you are using for your appeal. You must send a copy of the appeal to the director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency no later than three (3) days after you file it with ERAC.

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

### OHIO EPA ISSUES FINAL MODIFIED HAZARDOUS WASTE PERMIT

On January 17, 2006, Ohio EPA issued a final class 2 modified Hazardous Waste Facility Installation and Operation Permit (Permit) to Safety Kleen Systems, Inc. for its facility at 581 Milliken Drive SE, Hebron, Ohio. The EPA Identification Number for this facility is OHD980587364.

#### **Why is Safety Kleen Systems, Inc. modifying its Permit?**

Safety Kleen Systems, Inc., is permitted to store hazardous waste in containers and tanks at its facility. Safety Kleen Systems, Inc., is requesting the 1) installation of new piezometers, monitoring wells, and stream gauges within sixty (60) days of approval of this modification; 2) designation of wells to be sampled for a modified list of appendix to OAC Rule 3475-54-98 constituents within sixty (60) days of approval to better define the chemicals of concern at the site, and; 3) specification of followup activities Safety-Kleen will take based on the data obtained. This final modified permit will allow Safety Kleen Systems, Inc. to make the requested changes. To issue this final modified Permit, Ohio EPA determined that the modification application is complete and meets appropriate standards.

#### **Can I appeal this final modified Permit?**

Yes, if you are an officer of an agency of the state or of a political subdivision, acting in a representative capacity, or any person who would be aggrieved or adversely affected by this modified Permit, you have the right to appeal this Permit decision to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (ERAC).

#### **If I decide to appeal this final modified Permit, how and when must I make the appeal?**

If you file an appeal, you must put it in writing no later than **February 18, 2006**. Your appeal must explain why you are appealing the action and the grounds you are using for your appeal. You must file your appeal, according to Ohio Revised Code § 3745.04, with ERAC at the following address: ***Environmental Review Appeals Commission***, 309 South Fourth Street, Room 222, Columbus, Ohio 43215. You must send a copy of the appeal to the director of Ohio EPA at the following address no later than three (3) days after you file it with ERAC: ***Joseph P. Koncelik, Director of Ohio EPA***, P.O. 

SUMMARY OF MODIFICATIONS TO HAZARDOUS WASTE  
INSTALLATION AND OPERATION PERMIT

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Modifications of the Hazardous Waste Facility Installation and Operation Permit will authorize Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc. to make the following changes at the Hebron Recycle Center:

**Class 2 Modifications:**

Section 10 of Safety-Kleen's Part B permit application was updated to outline the additional site investigation activities to be implemented at the site to better define the ground water contaminant plume at the Hebron facility and determine if current corrective measures are adequate. The changes include:

- Installation of new piezometers, monitoring wells, and stream gauges within sixty (60) days of approval of this modification;
- Designation of wells to be sampled for a modified list of appendix to OAC Rule 3745-54-98 constituents within sixty (60) days of approval to better define the chemicals of concern at the site;
- Specification of followup activities Safety-Kleen will take based on the data obtained.

In addition, changes to Module E of Safety-Kleen's hazardous waste permit terms and conditions were required to confirm the *additional site investigation activities and establish deadlines* for the work. Minor modifications or clarifications for those activities have also been incorporated into Module E as allowed by OAC Rule 3745-50-51(D)(2)(f)(i)(a). A revised Table of Contents and a new signed certification statement for the Part B permit application were also provided.
