
Dear Mr. Roberts:

On September 27, 2006, Ohio EPA received a notification for a Class 1 hazardous waste permit modification from Envirosafe Services of Ohio, Inc. (ESOI) located at 876 Otter Creek Road, Oregon, Ohio. Ohio EPA has evaluated the permit modification classification using the criteria found in paragraph (E)(2) of OAC Rule 3745-50-51 and in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-50-51(E)(1)(b) has determined that the permit modification meets the criteria of a class 1 permit modification. In addition, with this letter, Ohio EPA acknowledges the above referenced Class 1 modification submitted pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-50-51, and accordingly has updated the facility's Part B permit application and permit.

This modification to remove the form of precipitation from permit condition J.7(b)(iii) was assigned a permit information tracking system (PITS) ID number of OHD045243706-060927-1-2.

- (iii) the waste's identification cross referenced to the manifest document number.
- (b) For each operating day, the Permittee must record in the facility's operating record:
 - (i) measurements of wind direction;
 - (ii) average and maximum wind speed; and,
 - (iii) precipitation accumulated over the previous 24 hour period.
- (c) The Permittee must record leachate level readings in the Cell M subcells prior to the removal of leachate, and after completion of leachate removal activities at the end of the working day. Leachate level readings used to determine compliance with Permit Condition J.3(a)(i) or OAC Rule 3745-57-03(A)(2) must be taken and recorded at the end of the working day.
- (d) The Permittee must report to Ohio EPA on a monthly basis, the following information related to the primary and secondary leachate collection and removal systems of Cell M:
 - (i) daily on-site rainfall measurements;
 - (ii) as applicable, any daily operational problems associated with the systems (e.g., pumps inoperable, transducers inoperable, etc.);
 - (iii) daily leachate level readings before and after any leachate removal from the systems; and,
 - (iv) daily volumes of leachate removed from the systems.
- (e) The Permittee must provide to Ohio EPA analytical results of leachate from each sub-cell annually. Parameters to be tested are listed in Table K-1 (Constituents with Specified Comparison Standards), K-2 (Constituents with Comparison Standards) and K-3 (Ground Water Quality Parameters) of this permit.
