Dear Mr. Marsh:

On April 10, 2007, Ohio EPA received a request for a Class 1A (Class 1 requiring prior approval) hazardous waste permit modification (tracking number – 070416-1A-1) from RMI Titanium Co. Sodium Plant. With this letter, Ohio EPA approves the above referenced Class 1A modification submitted pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-50-51.

FOR APPROVAL

Permit Condition A.3 contains the Permit Effective/Expiration Date Limit of five years. With a recent amendment to the Ohio Administrative code (OAC) Rule 3745-50-54, a permittee may request the duration of a permit be extended from five years to ten years. The OAC Rule became effective July 11, 2005. Ohio EPA classified a modification to the permit duration as a Class 1A modification in a letter dated July 8, 2005. RMI's modification request dated April 10, 2007, requests that the duration of their permit be extended to ten years.

The following modification has been made to your Ohio Hazardous Waste Facility Installation and Operation Permit renewal journalized on July 19, 2007. No changes were made to the Part B permit application. The records of Ohio EPA have been changed accordingly:





In reference to the application of RMI Titanium Company Sodium Plant for an Ohio Hazardous Waste Facility Installation and Operation Renewal Permit under Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 3734 and the record in this matter, you are authorized to conduct at the above-named facility the following hazardous waste management activities:

A.3 Permit Effective/Expiration Date
OAC Rule 3745-50-54

The effective date of this permit is the date the permit is entered into the Director's Journal. The permit expiration date is July 19, 2012.

A.4 Severability

The provisions of this permit are severable, and if any provision of this permit, or the application of any provision of this permit to any circumstance, is held invalid, the application of such provision to other circumstances, and the remainder of this permit, shall not be affected thereby.

A.5 Duty to Comply
OAC Rule 3745-50-58(A)

The Permittee must comply with all applicable provisions of ORC Chapter 3734, all applicable Ohio hazardous waste rules, and all terms and conditions of this permit, except to the extent and for the duration such noncompliance is authorized by the laws of the State of Ohio. Any permit noncompliance, other than noncompliance authorized by the laws of the State of Ohio, constitutes a violation of ORC Chapter 3734 and is grounds for enforcement action, revocation, modification, denial of a permit renewal application or other appropriate action.

A.6 Duty to Reapply and Permit Expiration
OAC Rules 3745-50-40(D), 3745-50-58(B), 3745-50-56 and ORC Section 3734.05(H)

- (a) If the Permittee wishes to continue an activity allowed by this permit after the expiration date of this permit, the Permittee must submit a completed permit application for a hazardous waste facility installation and operation permit renewal and any necessary accompanying general plans, detailed plans, specifications, and such information as the Director may require, to the Director no later than one hundred eighty (180) days prior to the expiration date of this permit, unless a later submittal date has been authorized by the Director upon a showing of good cause.
