On May 28, 2013, the Air Port Taxi, Inc. (Airport Taxi) submitted to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) an amended post closure care and monitoring plan for a trichloroethylene tank spill at 1555 Joyce Avenue in Columbus, Ohio. Revisions to the post closure care and monitoring plan were received on August 19, 2013. The post-closure plan was submitted pursuant to the May 28, 2010 Director's Final Findings and Order in order to demonstrate that Airport Taxi's proposal for post-closure complies with the substantive requirements of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rules 3745-55-11, 3745-55-12 and 3745-55-18.

The owner or operator and the public were given the opportunity to submit written comments regarding the amended post-closure plan in accordance with the hazardous waste rule requirements. No public comments were received by Ohio EPA.

Based upon review of Airport Taxi's submittal and subsequent revision, I conclude that the amended post closure care and monitoring plan for the hazardous waste facility at 1555 Joyce Avenue in Columbus, Ohio meets the performance standard contained in OAC rule and complies with the pertinent parts of OAC 3745-55-12 and 3745-55-18.

The amended post closure care and monitoring plan submitted to Ohio EPA on May 28, 2013, and revised on August 19, 2013 by Airport Taxi is hereby approved.

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Compliance with the approved post closure care and monitoring plan is expected. Ohio EPA will monitor such compliance and reserves the right to take action, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code (ORC) chapters 3734 and 6111, and other applicable law, to enforce such compliance and to seek appropriate remedies in the event of noncompliance with the provisions of this approved post closure plan. Please be advised that approval of this post-closure plan does not release Airport Taxi from any responsibilities regarding corrective action for all releases of hazardous waste or constituents from any waste management unit, regardless of the time at which waste was placed in the unit.

You are hereby notified that this action of the director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to ORC Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within 30 days after notice of the director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00, made payable to "Ohio Treasurer," which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the director within three days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. When the post closure care period is completed, OAC rule 3745-55-20 requires the owner or operator of a facility to submit to the director of Ohio EPA, certification by the owner or operator and an independent, registered professional engineer that the facility has completed the post-closure care period in accordance with the approved post-closure plan. The certification by the owner or operator shall include the statement found in OAC rule 3745-50-42(D). The certification should be submitted to:
