Dear Interested Party:

In conformance with Ohio Revised Code (ORC) section 119.032 and the Division's interest to seek stakeholder input on our draft rules, we are providing notice of a draft rules package to our Interested Parties prior to the rules' filing with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review (JCARR). This letter is our notification to you that draft rules are now available for your review and comment.

This rules package contains 9 rules. These are rules that must be reviewed every five years and filed with JCARR, and we intend to make some non-substantive amendments to several of them. The list of rules in this package appears below. The procedures for obtaining a copy of these draft rules appears in Attachment A. They are available to download, or a hard copy can be made and mailed.

Please provide your comments to Kit Arthur regarding these draft rules by September 20, 2011; see Attachment A for comment submittal information. After that date, we will consider all comments received, revise the rules accordingly, and file them with JCARR. A public notice will be issued, but you will not receive another letter like this one regarding these rules. We intend to file these rules with JCARR in November 2011.

While we encourage you to look at these rules prior to their JCARR filing, this review and comment period on the Interested Parties draft rules does not constitute your only opportunity to participate in the rule-making process regarding these rules. A formal public comment period of about forty days, with a public hearing, will begin upon filing these rules with JCARR. If you choose not to review or comment on these draft rules at this time, you will have another chance to do so after they are filed with JCARR.

A detailed list of changes that are made between the draft rules and the proposed (originally filed with JCARR) rules will be maintained, and will be available after proposal.
