Re: Closure Period Extension Approval for Upper SASH Pad

Dear Mr. Krimmel:

On March 24, 2014, Hull & Associates, Inc., on behalf of Zaclon LLC, located at 2981 Independence Road, Cleveland, Ohio, submitted a request for an extension to the closure period specified in the approved amended closure plan for the Upper SASH Pad received February 2, 2012. This extension request was submitted pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-66-13(B), as closure will require longer than the time specified in the approved amended closure plan.

On December 5, 2013, Ohio EPA approved a minor modification to the 2012 approved amended closure plan. The minor modification detailed activities to complete excavation of the waste materials from the Upper SASH Pad in order to meet the closure performance standard. In accordance with the approved amended closure plan, removal activities were to be completed by April 4, 2014. However, due to the inclement weather and amount of snow present throughout the winter, Hull & Associates, Inc. has requested an extension until June 4, 2014 to complete removal actions.

My staff reviewed your request for an extension to the closure period, and recommends that the extension be granted per OAC rule 3745-66-13(B). I concur, and am therefore granting this extension

request. This extension is being granted for the above referenced amended closure plan to allow all removal activities to be completed by June 4, 2014.

Zaclon LLC shall continue to take all steps to prevent a threat to human health and the environment from the unclosed, but inactive waste management unit per OAC rule 3745-66-13(B)(2).

Please be advised that approval of this closure extension request does not release Zaclon LLC from any responsibilities as required under the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments of 1984, regarding corrective action for all releases of hazardous waste or constituents from any solid waste management unit, regardless of the time at which waste was placed in the unit.

You are hereby notified that this action of the director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00, made payable to "Ohio Treasurer of State," which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. 
When closure is completed, OAC rule 3745-66-15 requires the owner or operator of a facility to submit to the director of Ohio EPA, certification by the owner or operator and a registered professional engineer, that the facility has been closed in accordance with the approved amended closure plan. The certification by the owner or operator shall include the statement found in OAC rule 3745-50-42(D). These certifications should be submitted to:
