Dear Mr. Hall:

On December 19, 2005, Ohio EPA received Delphi Automotive Systems' (Delphi) request to update the post-closure cost estimate, financial assurance mechanism, post closure plan and corrective action program. For this modification, Delphi submitted a Class 2 permit modification application<sup>1</sup>. The Agency did not receive any verbal or written comments concerning the Class 2 modification. I have enclosed the final modified Ohio hazardous waste facility installation and operation permit (Permit) action that was issued by the director today. Please note that the modified Permit remains in effect until it is renewed, withdrawn, suspended or revoked.

You have the right to appeal this Permit decision to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (ERAC) no later than 30 days after the public notice (See Ohio Revised Code § 3745.04). You may file your appeal with ERAC at the following address: Environmental Review Appeals Commission, 309 South Fourth Street, Room 222, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

If you file an appeal, you must put it in writing. Your appeal must explain why you are appealing the action(s) and the grounds you are using for your appeal. You must send a copy of the appeal to the director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency no later than three (3) days after you file it with ERAC.



### OHIO EPA ISSUES FINAL MODIFIED HAZARDOUS WASTE PERMIT

On April 18, 2006, Ohio EPA issued a final class 2 modified Hazardous Waste Facility Installation and Operation Permit (Permit) to Delphi Automotive Systems L.L.C., for its facility at North River Road at Larchmont, Warren, Ohio 44486. The EPA Identification Number for this facility is OHD000817346.

#### **Why is Delphi Automotive Systems L.L.C. modifying its Permit?**

Delphi Automotive Systems L.L.C., (Delphi) manufactures electrical harnesses for the automotive industry and currently must have a permit to perform post-closure activities. Delphi wishes to update the post-closure cost estimate, financial assurance mechanism, post closure plan and corrective action program. This final modified permit will allow Delphi to make the requested changes. To issue this final Permit modification, Ohio EPA determined that the modification application is complete and meets appropriate standards.

#### **Can I appeal this final Permit modification?**

Yes, if you are an officer of an agency of the state or of a political subdivision, acting in a representative capacity, or any person who would be aggrieved or adversely affected by this modified Permit, you have the right to appeal this Permit decision to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (ERAC).

#### **If I decide to appeal this final Permit modification, how and when must I make the appeal?**

If you file an appeal, you must put it in writing no later than **May 22, 2006**. Your appeal must explain why you are appealing the action and the grounds you are using for your appeal. You must file your appeal, according to Ohio Revised Code § 3745.04, with ERAC at the following address: ***Environmental Review Appeals Commission***, 309 South Fourth Street, Room 222, Columbus, Ohio 43215. You must send a copy of the appeal to the director of Ohio EPA at the following address no later than three (3) days after you file it with ERAC: ***Joseph P. Koncelik, Director of Ohio EPA***, P.O. 

**SUMMARY OF MODIFICATIONS TO HAZARDOUS WASTE  
INSTALLATION AND OPERATION PERMIT**

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Modification of the Hazardous Waste Facility Installation and Operation Permit will authorize Delphi Automotive Systems to make the following change:

**Class 2 Modification:**

- 1) Delphi Automotive Systems L.L.C (Delphi) has requested a non-appendix modification to update the post-closure cost estimate, financial assurance mechanism, post closure plan and ground water monitoring program. The post-closure cost estimate and financial assurance mechanism updates are required by a compliance schedule condition of the current operating permit.

Delphi has four closed surface impoundments, for which the facility is in post-closure. The current post-closure plan states that the facility is in the corrective action phase of the ground water monitoring program. This modification will end the corrective action phase of the ground water monitoring program and place the facility in compliance monitoring. The modification changes the ground water monitoring network to reduce the frequency and number of wells sampled. The facility has also been required to enter into an environmental covenant with the Ohio EPA to ensure on-site ground water use is restricted. Delphi will remain subject to corrective action if the ground water protection standard is exceeded at the ground water monitoring network.
