Dear Mr. Rihtar:

On February 13, 2014, ArcelorMittal, located at 3060 Eggers Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio, submitted a revised request for an extension to the closure period specified in the Approved Closure Plan. The Approved Closure Plan/Revision 8, along with its corresponding Ground Water Monitoring Plan (GWMP)/Revision 1, was approved on April 4, 2006, to complete closure of the following hazardous waste unit:

- Former Cadence Product Storage Unit – The Cadence Product Storage Unit was an 80,000 gallon aboveground storage tank used to store Cadence Product 312, a blend of various materials, which included paint sludge and solvents.

An extension request to complete all closure activities was made on March 22, 2011. The 2011 request was approved and the closure period was extended to end on April 15, 2013.

Closure activities were not completed as of the April 2013 deadline. On October 15, 2013, ArcelorMittal requested an additional twenty-four months to April 15, 2015, to complete all closure activities. The extension request was submitted pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-66-13(B), as closure will require longer than the 180 day period as specified in OAC rule 3745-66-13.

A revised closure schedule was determined based on discussions during a February 12, 2014, meeting between ArcelorMittal and the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA). Subsequently, the October 2013 request for closure extension was withdrawn.

ArcelorMittal requested a revised closure extension to August 31, 2014, to allow for the following:

- the preparation and submittal of an Amended Closure Plan by April 1, 2014, and
- the preparation and submittal of the Closure Certification report.

My staff reviewed your request for an extension to the closure period and recommends that the extension be granted as per OAC rule 3745-66-13(B). I concur and am therefore granting this extension request. This extension is being granted for the above referenced closure plan and expires on August 31, 2014.

ArcelorMittal shall continue to take all steps to prevent a threat to human health and the environment from the unclosed, but inactive waste management unit, per OAC rule 3745-66-13(B)(2).

Please be advised that approval of this closure extension request does not release ArcelorMittal from any responsibilities as required under the 1984 Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments regarding corrective action for all releases of hazardous waste or constituents from any solid waste management unit, regardless of the time at which waste was placed in the unit.

You are hereby notified that this action of the director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission, pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00, made payable to "*Treasurer, State of Ohio*," which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. When closure is completed, OAC rule 3745-66-15 requires the owner or operator of a facility to submit to the director of Ohio EPA, certification by the owner or operator and an independent, registered professional engineer that the facility has been closed in accordance with the specifications in the approved closure plan. The certification shall follow the format specified in OAC rule 3745-50-42(D), and should be submitted to:
