**RE: NEW CLOSURE PLAN APPROVAL - REMOVAL
BEDFORD ANODIZING COMPANY, OHD087715686**

Dear Mr. DeWeese and Mr. Poole:

On June 28, 2011, Compliance Technologies Inc., on your behalf, submitted to Ohio EPA a new closure plan for the unlawful hazardous waste management units, consisting of the Short and Long Line areas, located at 7010 Krick Road, in Walton Hills, Ohio. Revisions to the closure plan were received on September 23 and October 19, 2011. The original plan was submitted pursuant to the April 27, 2011 Consent Order (Cuyahoga County Court of Common Pleas, Case No. CV10718623). The closure plan was submitted pursuant to rule 3745-66-12 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) in order to demonstrate that Bedford Anodizing Company's and the Ronald G. Poole Trust's proposal for closure complies with the substantive requirements of OAC rules 3745-55-11 and 3745-55-12.

The owner or operator and the public were given the opportunity to submit written comments regarding the closure plan in accordance with the hazardous waste rule requirements. No public comments were received by Ohio EPA.

Based upon review of Bedford Anodizing Company's and the Ronald G. Poole Trust's submittal and subsequent revisions, I conclude that the closure plan for the hazardous waste facility at 7010 Krick Road, in Walton Hills, Ohio, meets the performance standard contained in OAC rule 3745-55-11 and complies with the pertinent parts of OAC rule 3745-55-12.

The closure plan submitted to Ohio EPA on June 28, 2011, and revised on September 23 and October 19, 2011 by Bedford Anodizing Company and the Ronald G. Poole Trust is hereby approved.

Compliance with the approved closure plan is expected. Ohio EPA will monitor such compliance. Ohio EPA expressly reserves the right to take action, pursuant to chapters 3734. and 6111. of the Ohio Revised Code, and other applicable law, to enforce such compliance and to seek appropriate remedies in the event of noncompliance with the provisions and modifications of this approved closure plan. Please be advised that approval of this closure plan does not release Bedford Anodizing Company and the Ronald G. Poole Trust from any responsibilities regarding corrective action for all releases of hazardous waste or constituents from any waste management unit, regardless of the time at which waste was placed in the unit.

You are hereby notified that this action of the director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00, made payable to "Ohio Treasurer Josh Mandel," which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. When closure is completed, OAC rule 3745-55-15 requires the owner or operator of a facility to submit to the director of Ohio EPA, certification by the owner or operator and an independent registered professional engineer, that the facility has been closed in accordance with the approved closure plan. The certification by the owner or operator must include the statement found in OAC rule 3745-50-42(D). These certifications should be submitted to:
