Dear Project Stakeholder:

Please see the attached letter from Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Director Craig Butler outlining the Agency's plan to rotate staff facility assignments. The purpose of rotating staff is to make sure we are doing our job in a fair and responsible way and to provide you with the best customer service. We believe staff rotation will enhance the uniformity of project oversight while also providing new perspectives and ideas, greatly improving the effectiveness of our efforts.

The Division of Environmental Response and Revitalization (DERR) staff assignments will change approximately every five to six years. For most projects, we will look for a logical break point (e.g., at the conclusion of the investigation) to make the switch to avoid disrupting a project with a new coordinator. You can count on division supervision, support staff and your previous coordinator to answer questions you may have or provide technical assistance to ensure project continuity. We will begin making the rotations in October; for some projects, staff rotations may not occur for several years.
