Underground mine.

(A) Neither the limits of waste placement of the industrial facility nor any leachate storage structure nor any leachate conveyance apparatus shall be located within an area of potential subsidence due to an underground mine. The area of potential subsidence due to an underground mine is the area defined by the angle of draw, extending from the underground mine to where the angle of draw intercepts the ground surface. The angle of draw shall not be less than fifteen degrees.

(B) This rule does not apply if the underground mine has been removed.

(C) This rule does not apply if the underground mine has been filled sufficiently to result in the elimination of the potential for subsidence.
