

3745-525-440            Summary.

(A) The summary information included within an application for a permit to install to establish or modify an industrial facility shall be prepared in accordance with this rule and in the manner specified in rule 3745-525-400 of the Administrative Code. The summary information shall be included in a summary section.

(B) Information regarding wastes to be disposed in the industrial facility.

[Comment: Wastes that can be disposed in an industrial facility are limited by rules 3745-525-615 and 3745-525-625 of the Administrative Code.]

(C) All requests to use an alternative as provided for in rules 3745-525-205 to 3745-525-294 and in rules 3745-525-700 to 3745-525-770 of the Administrative Code.

(D) For an industrial solid waste landfill, the requested authorized maximum daily waste receipt, if any.

(E) If the industrial facility exclusively disposes of industrial waste generated by the owner of the industrial facility, a description of efforts at the original source of generation to prevent or reduce generation of the industrial waste, and efforts to recycle or reuse the industrial waste in a manner other than disposal.

(F) A demonstration that the industrial facility will meet the applicable criteria for permit approval specified in rules 3745-525-310 and 3745-525-315 of the Administrative Code. The demonstration shall include a summary of the industrial facility environs and a discussion of the owner's or operator's compliance with the applicable authorizing documents.

(G) A list of the permits, licenses, plan approvals, authorizations, or other approvals that have been applied for and the local, state, or federal office or agency where application has been made.

(H) A discussion of how the proposed ground water monitoring system meets the requirements of rule 3745-506-100 of the Administrative Code.

(I) If putrescible waste, as determined by rule 3745-525-602 of the Administrative Code, will be disposed at the industrial facility, a discussion on how the proposed explosive gas monitoring locations meet the requirements of rules 3745-525-910 and 3745-525-915 of the Administrative Code.
