



Re: Interested Party Review – Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) Landfill and Scrap Tire Monofill and Monocell Rules

Dear Interested Parties:

The Division of Materials and Waste Management is in the process of conducting a review of the regulations for MSW landfills and scrap tire monofill and monocells. This review is being conducted to satisfy requirements mandated by Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 119.032 which requires all state agencies to review each of their rules every five years to determine whether or not to continue the rules without change, amend the rules, or rescind the rules.

DMWM has reviewed the current effective rules and has decided that the following municipal solid waste landfill and scrap tire monofill and monocell rules should be retained without change. The following rules are included in this package:

3745-27-71	Additional criteria for approval of scrap tire monofill facility permit to install application.
3745-27-72	Scrap tire monofill facility construction.
3745-27-73	Final closure of a scrap tire monofill facility.
3745-27-74	Post closure care of scrap tire monofill facilities.
3745-27-75	Operational criteria for a scrap tire monofill facility.
