**Public Notice
Proposed Rulemaking Governing
Solid Waste Incinerator and Scrap Tire Rules**

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection, under the authority of Sections 119.032 of the Ohio Revised Code and in accordance with Chapter 119, proposes to amend the following rule of the Ohio Administrative Code:

- 3745-27-52 Operation of solid waste incinerator or solid waste energy recovery facilities.
- 3745-27-78 Beneficial use of scrap tires.
- 3745-27-79 Soil, surface water, and ground water contamination characterization and remediation caused by open burning of scrap tires.

These rules address solid waste incinerator and scrap tire regulations.

The purpose of this rule making is to correct minor reference errors contained in these rules.

The public comment period will run until October 20, 2014. A public hearing on this proposed rule making will be held to consider public comments in accordance with Section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code. This hearing will be held on October 20, 2014 at 10:30 a.m. at Ohio EPA, Lazarus Government Center, 50 W. Town Street, Suite 700, Columbus, Ohio.

To facilitate the scheduling of oral presentations, persons intending to give testimony at the hearing should notify the Ohio EPA Public Interest Center, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus, Ohio 43216-1049, (614) 644-2160. Prior registration will ensure that registrants are heard ahead of those individuals who register at the hearing. Oral testimony may be limited to five minutes, depending on the number of persons testifying. All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented and to present oral and/or written comments concerning the proposed rule making.

Written testimony should be sent to the attention of Michelle Braun at the Division of Materials and Waste Management (DMWM), P.O. Box 1049, Columbus Ohio 43216-1049. Written comments may also be submitted to the Hearing Officer at the public hearing. Written testimony will receive the same consideration as oral testimony. All testimony received at the hearing or by close of business on October 20, 2014 will be considered by Ohio EPA prior to final action on this rulemaking proposal. Written comments submitted after this date may be considered as time and circumstances permit.
