






Local Government Innovation Program

Local Government Innovation Program Past Projects




Fairfield County- Advanced Innovative Management Solution- Feasibility Study Grant & subsequent Loan to implement shared document imaging solution for several entities. Faster access to documents cross-agency

Beavercreek Township Fire Department- Loan
Migration to Ohio's P-25 Multi-Agency Radio Communications System (MARCS)


Mercer County Engineer and all surrounding townships- several loan awards to create a centralized road maintenance department that serves all county and township roads

Local Government Efficiency Program

Incentivizes the use of Lean or Six Sigma process improvement concepts to provide more efficient services.

Application Process

- Applications deadlines quarterly (early March, June, September, December)
- Grants and Loans (for either program) are awarded quarterly by the Local Government Innovation Council
- Scholarships are approved on a rolling basis
