RE: Big Foot Run Closed Landfill Compliance Monitoring Plan, Warren County

Dear Ms. Dall,

Bigfoot Run Landfill (Facility) is a closed municipal solid waste landfill that ceased accepting waste in May of 1999. The Facility is subject to the requirements of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-10(F). On September 19, 2006, the Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) issued a letter which required implementation of the Corrective Measures Plan (CMP) submitted on December 21, 2005, and selected the corrective measures to be undertaken at the Facility in accordance with the CMP. The CMP includes a Corrective Measures Monitoring Plan (CMMP) for the Facility ground water monitoring wells.

There have been several changes at the Facility which required revisions to the CMP.

These include:

- In March, 2009, a statistically significant increase in chloroethane was documented and confirmed.
- In September, 2011, the owner/operator was advised that six (6) groundwater monitoring wells located off-site on property not owned by the owner/operator would no longer be accessible. These wells are identified as Z-510I, Z-510D, Z-704, Z-706I, and Z-706S used for water levels and CR-1 which was sampled semiannually.
- The CMP/CMMP has been updated to include revised well logs, tables and appendices.

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On April 11, 2012, Ohio EPA received a document titled "Revision 4 – November 2011", which proposes revisions to the CMP for the Facility. Ohio EPA has reviewed the document and all associated data and has determined that it fulfills the requirements of OAC Rule 3745-27-10(F).

The owner/operator shall continue to implement the CMP and CMMP with the following revisions:

1. The groundwater remediation standard (GWRS) for chloroethane is 217 ug/l.
2. Groundwater monitoring wells Z-510I, Z-510D, Z-704, Z-706I, Z-706S and CR-1 are no longer part of the CMP or CMMP.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer – State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section.
