Subject: October 2013 Revised Statistical Analysis Plan – Revision 4

Dear Mr. Flory:

On October 25, 2013, Ohio EPA received the October 2013 revised Statistical Analysis Plan from Eagon & Associates, Inc. on behalf of the Solid Waste Authority of Central Ohio (SWACO). According to the document, you requested some statistically significant data shown to be false positives and some outliers be included in background along with a general update to background that includes data through the Spring 2013 semiannual sampling event. Pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g) background data can be added only in blocks of data resulting from the analysis of four or more statistically independent samples after the data has been statistically compared to current background data and no statistical differences are detected, unless another method is deemed acceptable to the Director.

Ohio EPA's Division of Drinking and Ground Waters (DDAGW) has reviewed the proposal and the Division of Materials and Waste Management concurs that this data can be added to the background database. Therefore, pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g), SWACO is authorized to add those outliers identified in the statistical plan to the background database for the Franklin County Sanitary Landfill.


You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to ORC Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." The Commission, in its discretion, may reduce the fee if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. An appeal may be filed with the Environmental Review Appeals Commission at the following address:
